JEAN-MICHEL WILMOTTE

Jean-Michel Wilmotte was born in 1948 and is a French architect, urban planner and designer, member of the Académie des Beaux-Arts. He founded Wilmotte & Associés architecture firm in Paris in 1975.

From Dallas to Seoul, via Moscow, Dakar and São Paulo, Jean-Michel Wilmotte and his teams have been travelling the world for more than 45 years, placing people, culture, heritage and innovation at the heart of their creations.

Jean-Michel Wilmotte is equally curious about all subjects: from the most unlikely to the most obvious, from the most high-end to the most accessible, from the smallest to the most imposing. Over the years, the agency has diversified and now works mainly in five areas: architecture, interior architecture, museography, urban planning and design. Jean-Michel Wilmotte likes to be where he is not expected. Changes of scale and programme allow him to remain on the lookout, to question and reinvent himself each time, always with the same demand for quality and the same attention to detail.

Wilmotte & Industries design studio was founded as an indispensible extension to the projects managed by the architectural firm and has built a solid reputation in the field of industrial and object design. The studio works with numerous firms and manufacturers in France, Italy, Germany and the United States. This "architect's design" is characterised by great care taken over composition and a keen awareness of materials and finishes. Its pure and simple lines aim to convey readability, coherence and the authenticity of the object and a certain form of timelessness.

AGRAPHE 2018 / 2025



Agraphe is a generously sized wall lamp, originally designed for the restoration of the Lutetia Hotel in Paris. The metal structure endowed with junction clasps, characteristic of Wilmotte's work, supports a double layer of fused and textured Murano glass, handcrafted by skilled artisans. All these details come together to create a timeless and sophisticated piece.





CYLINDRE

1983 / 2025



Designed in 1983 for the Academy collection, Cylindre reflects Wilmotte's design approach in working with simple forms. It is a formal seat, entirely made from a square-section iron tube, bent and welded to form an emblematic silhouette of the 1980s.

The soft cushioning for the seat and backrest is upholstered in carefully selected Italian leather.







ÉLYSÉE 1983 / 2025



Created for the private apartments of French President Mitterrand at the Élysée Palace, this stool, named after the presidential residence, has become one of Wilmotte's iconic pieces. The gently curved lines in veneered walnut wood makes this seat a small architectonic object of perfect symmetry.









PUPITRE 2018 / 2025



Designed for the renovation of the historic Lutetia Hotel in Paris in 2018, Pupitre desk embodies the essential characteristics of a contemporary product. The metal base with fine-edged legs, supporting a walnut top, has a light and sober shape. Its elegant and discreet design makes it a perfect complement in different spaces.






Élysée

Weight: 6 Kg





Cylindre

Weight: 11 Kg






Pupitre
